



TimberSaver® PT 20-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY PROGRAM

For CSI to be able to honor a 20-Year Limited Warranty in the State of Hawaii, the following procedures and conditions must be followed or met. Additional details can be found on the TimberSaver® PT 20-year Limited Warranty Certificate.

1. The Contractor, Builder, or Homeowner wishing its residential structure to be warranted must supply in writing to the lumber dealer the name of project or owner, the individual address of the structure(s) and the name, address, and phone number of the contractor before construction starts.
2. The lumber dealer must forward this information to CSI before construction starts.
3. The Contractor must notify CSI and the "Inspector" if the structure intended to be warranted contains treated wood other than TimberSaver PT borate-treated wood ("OTHER WARRANTIED WOOD" as defined in Appendix A of the TimberSaver PT 20-year Limited Warranty Certificate). All warranted structures must contain a substantial quantity of TimberSaver PT borate treated wood.

Proof of purchase for all warranted lumber and plywood must be made available to CSI and its inspectors upon request.

4. CSI will notify the "Inspector" of the job and the name and phone number of the person he should contact in the Contractor's office to schedule his inspections prior to start of construction. The inspector shall be a person or persons specifically appointed in writing by CSI to inspect each warranted project.
5. The Inspector shall visit each jobsite at least once and as many additional times as required to properly inspect the installation of all pressure-treated wood.

6. The Inspector, upon completion of his inspection, shall complete the CSI "Inspection Report."
7. Upon completion of the residence, the Contractor shall complete the "Contractor's Qualification Certificate" and forward it to the Inspector.
8. The inspector shall send both the Inspection Report and the Contractor's Qualification Certificate to CSI in Charlotte, North Carolina.
9. CSI will have a "TimberSaver PT 20-Year Limited Warranty Certificate" issued for each warranted resident and have it sent to the appropriate party as instructed (such as the lumber supplier, treater, contractor, or owner).
10. In the event an existing warranted structure is to be altered or added to, the original Warranty can be kept in force if the owner will notify CSI or its treater and have the alteration or addition inspected by CSI's approved Inspector. The Inspector shall fill out a CSI "TimberSaver PT Addition/Alteration Inspection Report" and forward it to CSI in Charlotte, North Carolina. If all is proper, CSI will issue a notification that the additions and alterations are included and covered under the original Warranty for the balance of its time.

WARRANTY CLAIM PROCEDURES

Upon learning of a possible claim, CSI or its appointed representative will authorize the Inspector or others it so chooses to inspect the property. The person inspecting the property shall execute a "TimberSaver PT Warranty Claim Inspection Report" and file it with CSI in Charlotte, North Carolina, within 10 days of the inspection (consult the Warranty for terms and conditions of reporting a claim).

CSI will then process the claim and contact the proper party regarding settlement.
